11. ACTC Awards Evening

The date of the awards evening is now Saturday 6th June at Padbrook Park. Giles gave an update on the evening and its future, club members and delegates are asked to support the evening.

12. Championship Quality Report

Dave Haizelden had nothing to report but did say that with the new web-site ACTC clubs and their members can now comment on quality on line.

13. MSA Trials Committee Report

Very little to report. The MSA have clarified that on Classic Trials two fire extinguishers can be carried to make up the 1.75 litre requirement **BUT** if two are carried they **MUST** be a minimum capacity of **1 litre EACH**.

14. Stroud & Dist. MC Agenda Item

14.1 There was further discussion on the Stroud & Dist. MC proposal for a Regional championship. Some clubs felt this was a 'non starter.' Stroud & Dist. MC were asked to come back to Council with a detailed plan.

15. Ross & District Motor Sports Club Agenda Item

15.1 R&DMSC want to change the date of the Kyrle Trial in 2016 to avoid the Goshawk nesting season. The date of Sunday 6th November was suggested and this is being investigated at the first instance with the Forestry Commission. If any date change is made it will be reported to all delegates.

16. Fellside AC Agenda Item

16.1 The matter of Liege with a Citroen engine has been settled. The driver has been told that his car must run in Class 8.

17. Stroud & Dist. MC Agenda Item

17.1 Discussion on all the technical regulations. This will be taken up by the Technical Committee at a meeting to take place on Saturday 25th July.

18. ACTC Trophies

18.1 Trophy Cost Review. The cost of replicas are rising, over the past 3 years the replica cost have gone from £350 to £400 to £450. A cap of £400 will be applied to trophies. This will be reviewed based on the number of competitors entering the various Championships each year. **Action: Giles Greenslade**

18.2 Motorcycle Trophies. There are several trophies still missing and unaccounted for despite lots of investigation. A volunteer is still required to take charge of the motorcycle trophies. If no-one is found to take on this job then the motorcycle trophies will no longer be awarded. We need a motorcyclist to step-up and take over this role.

19. Championship Schedules

19.1 Issue 1 of the 2015 Schedule was circulated with the meeting agenda. Torbay Trial should be March 13th.

19.2 Draft 2 of the 2016 Schedule was circulated with the meeting agenda. It was decided that the first meeting of the ACTC Council should be held on the afternoon of the ACTC Awards evening on Saturday 4th June 2016. Proposed by Torbay and seconded by VWOC(GB), For 8, Against 2 so the motion was carried. This needs changing in the 2016 schedule.

20. Championship Reports

20.1 Car, Motorcycle reports provided by Chris Phillips.

21. Any Other Business

20.1 The use of video taken on trials and used to prove a point is irrelevant. Marshals are judges of fact and only their decisions will be used.

20.2 The MSA rules on using 'in car' video are very clear. A video camera can only be fitted to a car if it has been agreed with the Clerk of the Course AND the car must be presented to the scrutineer with the camera and mountings in place to be judged as acceptable.

20.3 It was stated that competitors have noted that there is a lack of consistency trial to trial with regulations and in particular penalties for striking markers. It was generally agreed that differences between trials was part of the character of Classic Trials and the onus was on the entrant to read and understand the regulations and final instructions.

20.4 It was suggested that the ACTC should have a central data base of marshals. It was felt that most clubs had their own data base and due to the wide area classic trials take place it would be difficult to get marshals from the north to go south and visa versa.

20.5 It was reported that the Technical Committee had met that morning and the TC was to be streamlined. The core committee would be, ACTC Chairman, Class 7 Co-ordinator, Motorcycle co-ordinator, MCC Rep. Stroud & Dist MC Rep. In addition knowledgeable persons from different classes would be co-opted as and when required.

20.6 The subject of ballast and repositioning ballast once the car had been scrutineered was raised. The MSA regulations state that ballast may not be moved. Under MSA regulations tools, spare parts and cans of fuel are NOT ballast and thus can be moved.

Marketing Update – April 2015

The current strategy is to target those people who already involved in some way or have some existing knowledge of the Sport, and the aim is to try and satisfy two objectives.

1. To help encourage new people to participate in our Sport
2. To encourage existing Competitors to join the ACTC and compete in the Championships

To bring new people in to the Sport my approach so far has been to produce some leaflets titled “**Do you enjoy what you see? Ever fancied taking part**” with some very basic information and links to the ACTC Website. Given the large numbers of spectators who gather at Simms and Blue Hills I considered these to be my captive audience so went along to both events this year and distributed approx 80 leaflets in total.

My next plan is to get a couple of A0 (120x85cm) laminated posters created together with a simple stand (probably made from a Wallpapering table) which is not only for display at areas such as Simms and Blue Hills, but also at Event sign-on/sign-off areas. This will help in meeting both of the above objectives.

To proceed with this I would like to ask the ACTC Committee for a modest budget allocation of around £50, and I would like to ask the Clubs permission to put up an ACTC display in a prominent area at their events.

Regarding Guidance on Extinguisher Position Re. agenda.

Scrutineering card returns are improved on last year but many have incomplete MOT dates, existing faults are not marked as corrected or second warning given.

No details or request for cards was received for the Cotswold Clouds for the 2nd year running. This was mentioned to Stroud Rep. last year but I have had no feedback.

Mud flap height has been changed in the Blue book I think most vehicles will now comply but just need to check at scrutineering

When I first agreed to take the job of scrutineer for the ACTC one of the main reasons given was to have continuity in the job, as club officials all had their own particular ideas as to what should be correct.

I was probably the same but at least it was the same at each event. Over the years the club scrutineers who we were assisting seem to have disappeared from many events so they have not been there to use our system.

I am quite happy to scrutineer the events I can get to and continue printing the cards but unless the returns are kept up to date and correct we lose the continuity,

We did a noise test on the Exmoor Trial two cars were over the limit and received verbal warnings although several cars are running very close so if the limit was lowered there would be several over.
