Edinburgh Trial, Saturday 30th September 2017

I am pleased to invite you to join our visit to Derbyshire. The event will follow a similar route to that used last year but with fewer trunk roads in the night, and will include most of last year's sections, with a possibility of one or two new ones.

- Single start at the Moto services on the M42 (J10) / A5 junction near Tamworth
- Total mileage approximately 200
- Finish at the Bull in the Thorn, Hurdlow (A515 south of Buxton).

The Edinburgh Trial will also cater for Class 'O' and Class 'R' following a similar routes as the other classes but avoiding some of the rougher sections. Class 'O' and 'R' competitors will not qualify for normal awards.

Most members are now expected to enter using the online system. If you have received Regulations and Entry Forms through the post you are one of a tiny minority. Please return the entry form immediately, fully completed to avoid delays, if you are to be assured of an entry. The entry is limited to 300 competitors and these are allocated in order of receipt.

Insurance for motorcycle competitors is now included within the ACU policies at no additional cost. For car competitors the club have arranged compulsory insurance through Locktons. The premiums are in the entry form.

If you are not entering, please come to help marshal. Without any help in this respect, it would be impossible to run events such as the Edinburgh Trial. If you are interested in marshalling, you will find attached a provisional list of sections and their approximate timings. Additional Supplementary Regulations

1. Governed by the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association Ltd., incorporating the provisions of the sporting code of the F.I.A. The National Sporting Code of the A.C.U. these regulations and the M.C.C. Standing Supplementary Regulations dated 2016 as amended by any written instructions that may be issued for the event. Copies of the MCC SSR's have been sent to all members but additional copies are available from the Membership Secretary, John Childs, 57, Ash Grove, Wheathamstead, St. Albans, AL4 8DF on receipt of a stamped addressed C5 envelope.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to members of the M.C.C. and by invitation to the V.S.S.C., the V.M.C.C., the Morgan 3-Wheeler Club, the British Armed Forces Motorcycle Association and the Federation of British Police Motor Clubs riding motor cycles. M.C.C. members must have paid their 2017 subscription.. All entrants must produce an M.O.T. certificate for their vehicle where applicable.

4. **START AND FINISH:** Starting from **Moto Services** on the M42 (J10) / A5 junction.
Competitors will leave in numerical order at one minute intervals. Competitors must sign on at least 30 minutes before their own starting time.
Standard starting time 00.00 Saturday 30th September 2017.
Finishing at The Bull in the Thorn, Hurdlow (A515 south of Buxton).
The route indicated on the Route Card must be followed throughout. The onus of finding the correct route rests with the competitor. There may be one or more route checks. The contents and instructions of the Route Card and any supplementary written instructions must be considered as part of these regulations. Mileage approximately 200.
5. **AWARDS** will be as M.C.C. 2016 S.S.R.'s.

THE JOHN TUCKER-PEAKE CUP for the best performance in the Motor Car Classes

ENTRY FORM: Edinburgh Trial 30th September 2017

1. I wish to enter the 2017 Edinburgh Trial and declare that the particulars given on this form are correct in every respect.
2. Held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and or the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and the Final Instructions.
 - 2.1 **M.S.A. DECLARATION** I declare that:
 - a 'I declare that I have been given the opportunity to read the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association and, if any, the Supplementary Regulations for this event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit and competent to take part in the event. I understand that motorsport is dangerous and accidents causing death, injury, disability and property damage can and do happen. I understand that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss and I acknowledge and accept these risks.
 - b The use of the vehicle hereby entered will be covered by insurance as required by the law which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the law.
 - c If I am the Parent or Guardian of the driver 'I understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and the General Regulations of the MSA.' As the Parent/Guardian 'I confirm that I have acquainted myself and the minor with the MSA General Regulations, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations (to include any appendices thereto) and hereby agree to be bound by those Regulations and submit myself without reserve to the consequences resulting from those Regulations (and any subsequent alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay as liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in Part 3, Appendix 1.' Note1 Where the Parent is not present there must be a Guardian who must produce a written and signed authorisation from the Parent/Guardian to act as their representative.
 - 2.2 **ACU ENTRY DECLARATION:** I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -
 - I hereby declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
 - I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of event I am entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
 - I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU permitted competition or on the ACU Stop List as a result of incurring a Concussion injury
 - I accept that insurance arranged on my behalf by the organisers of events that I may enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in a high risk activity.
 - I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course.
 - I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
 - I confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose. I confirm that I am eligible to compete on the machines for which I have entered.
 - I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
 - I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
 - I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.
 - 2.3 **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RISKS OF MOTORSPORT:** I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.
I have read the above and acknowledge that my participation in motorsport is entirely at my own risk. I agree that I am required to register on arrival by "signing on" at the designated place before taking part in any Practice Session or Race.
I have read and understood the standing supplementary regulations for this event.
