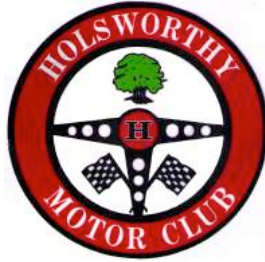

A Clubman's Event For Solo and Outfit Motorcycles

A Round of the 2018 ACTC Motorcycle Classic Trial Championship,
And Red Rose Bowl for motorcycle combinations

We are grateful to the Kivells Auctioneers for allowing their car park and facilities at the Holsworthy Cattle Market to be used for the start again this year

The ACTC motorcycle coordinator has suggested that we include a Class X to enable those who might be interested in trying out our sport to compete on their existing machines (see Sec 6 Classes below)

We should have at least 17 sections and 2 special tests in a route of 55 miles.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. EVENT

Holsworthy Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman's Motorcycle Classic Reliability Trial on Sunday 18th February 2018. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the of the AMCA, these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

2. ELIGIBILITY

This ACTC championship event is open to members of Holsworthy Motor Club as well as members of all ACTC affiliated clubs.

If your club is not affiliated to ACTC you will need to obtain Holsworthy MC membership £2.50 for a one day membership or £10.00 for a full years membership.

All competitors must produce, at signing-on, a valid Club Membership Card, Championship Registration Letter (where appropriate) A valid MOT Certificate must be produced at scrutineering.

3. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The event will be round of the ACTC Classic Trials Championship. For solo motorcycles a round of the Pouncy league and for combinations a round of the Red Rose Bowl league.

4. START

The start will be in the car park of The Holsworthy Cattle Market (MR190-347053) Competitors must sign-on (after scrutineering) at least 45 minutes before their due start time (which will be advised in the Final Instructions)

The first competitor will start at 09.00hrs. The motorcycles start at 30-second intervals in numerical order.

5. COURSE

Public roads will be used to link sections. The route will cover approximately 55 miles and include 17 sections and 2 special tests on public and private land. The route card will be issued with the final instructions (**provided the correct size envelope has been supplied**) and competitors failing to follow the authorized route will be liable to exclusion. Route checks may operate during the event.

6. CLASSES

A Solo motorcycle of British manufacture (generally pre 1970)

B1 Solo motorcycles up to and including 225cc

B2 Solo motorcycles from 226cc up to 450cc

D Motorcycle combinations

X For Solos and Combinations not complying with: - Sidecar construction regulations, tyre regulations or not complying with ACTC length of wheelbase regulations. (Minimum wheelbase of 1350mm)

Class X riders will compete amongst the other riders, will be included in the results but will not be eligible for any awards

All motorcycles must comply with the Safety Regulations concerning levers footrests and closing throttles.

All motorcycles must have front and rear lights fitted and working correctly.

All vehicles must be MOT tested if legally required.

All vehicles must have a valid road tax and be covered by insurance.

All vehicles must have an effective silencer fitted. **Any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start**

7. TYRES

All tyres must be suitable for **on road use**.

Bikes not using official trials tyres should enter or be put into class X

8. AWARDS

The Putshole Trophy

Best overall

The Smallbrook Woods Trophy

Passenger of winner in Class D

ALL CLASSES: Class Awards to winner of each class (except where the above main trophies awarded)

First Class Awards to second competitor in each class (subject to 5 starters in class)

Second Class Awards to third competitor in each class (subject to 8 starters in class)

Novice Award (subject to 3 starters). Ladies Award (subject to 3 starters)

No competitor may win more than one award. A Finishers Certificate will be awarded to each competitor signing-off. Points for club members on this event count towards the Bill Squires Trophy, the Mike Johns Trophy, the Annual Ladies' Award and the Marshals' Award. All awards will be decided by actual points lost - there will be no Index of Performance.

Awards for this event will be presented at the Holsworthy Motor Club Presentation Evening in early March 2020.

9. MARKING

Marking and penalties will be as stated in MSA Regulations T 7.5. In the event of a tie, aggregate times on the Special Tests will decide; if a tie still exists, the times on Special Test 1 will decide.

Sections will be sub-divided 12 – 0. **Hitting number markers is allowed on sections but not markers for restarts or on special tests.** Some sections will have re-starts for selected classes. **Motorcycle combinations will not have any re-starts**

10. ENTRIES

The maximum number of motorcycle entries is 58 and the minimum is 15. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of these minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as needed.

The Entry List opens on publication of these Regulations and closes **finally on Thursday 7th February 2019.** Entry fees are: - Solo Motorcycles & Outfits £25.00. Entry fees may be refunded if entry is withdrawn at least 7 days before the event, withdrawal refunds after this time will be subject to an administration fee at the discretion of the club.

IF YOU SELECT VIA POST PLEASE ENCLOSE WITH YOUR ENTRY TWO STAMPED SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPES SIZE 9” x 6.5” (A5) ONE FOR YOUR ROUTE CARD AND ONE FOR THE RESULTS. PLEASE SUPPLY SEPARATE ENVELOPES FOR EACH COMPETITOR. IF YOU HAVE SELECTED VIA EMAIL PLEASE ENSURE YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS IS WRITTEN CLEARLY.

12. STARTING ORDER

Starting order will be in order of receipt of entries (in Class)

13. RESULTS

Provisional results will be announced as soon as possible after the end of the event with a copy in writing to be sent within seven days. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA Regulations C.5.

14. IDENTIFICATION

Numbers, to be affixed in a prominent position to the front and rear of the vehicles (NOT THE COMPETITOR), will be supplied for the event. These numbers must be kept clearly legible throughout the event and must be removed immediately a competitor finishes (or retires). Numbers should be handed in at signing-off.

15. INSURANCE

Special additional insurance is required for this type of event. **The AMCA provides this free for motorcyclists.**

16. FINISH

The finish will be in ***The Bradworthy Inn*** beside The Square in Bradworthy, MR 190 325140, where competitors must sign a damage declaration and sign-off.

17. MISCELLANEOUS

IN THIS EVENT MOTORCYCLISTS ARE SOLEY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ROADWORTHINESS OF THEIR VEHICLES

Petrol will NOT be available on the route or at the start, however instructions on where to leave the route in order to get fuel will be included on the route card

Practicing on any section of the route at any time is forbidden and any competitor doing so will be excluded.

Any competitor involved in an accident must make a written report to the Secretary of the Meeting at the finish (or within seven days if a non-finisher).

Any vehicle whose appearance is below a standard appropriate to the event will not be allowed to start.

Final Instructions will be posted approximately 12th February 2019

Please note: This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. Be especially careful near horses – slow down, stop and switch off your engine if necessary.

Smoking is strictly forbidden anywhere near woodland or forestry.
