## Supplementary Regulations THE TESTING TRIAL

- Announcement** The Motor Cycling Club will run a Taster Classic Trial on 30th June 2019. The event will be governed by the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Regulations of Motorsports UK, the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the MCC SSRs as appropriate, these regulations and any written instructions which may be issued later.
- Permits** ACU No: Applied for Motorsports UK No: Applied For
- Insurance** RTA Insurance is not required as the whole event takes place on private land The A.C.U insurance will be Premier Cover
- The Event** This is a single venue on private ground at Westfield Farm, Coombe Hill, Keinton Mandeville, Somerset, TA11 6DQ O.S. Map Reference Sheet 183/549314 and will involve a number of classic trials sections which will be observed and timed.
- Classes** Normal MCC classes will not apply but there will be the following:  
Class B Solo motorcycles of any kind  
Class D Sidecar outfits and three wheeled cars  
Class 3 Closed cars  
Class 5 Open cars

All vehicles must comply with regulations for classic trials issued by the MSA, ACU and MCC. They must be road legal, including lighting, but on this occasion need not be taxed.

- Tests** There will be a number of sections each of which has to be attempted on each round. Each section will be both timed and observed with the following penalties:
  - Failure to complete the section  
with no time recorded 80 marks
  - Footing, hitting a marker, incorrect course,  
overshooting the finish 30 marks
  - Time penalties: Time in seconds equals marks lostPenalties under (b) and (c) will be added together up to a maximum of 80.

Time and weather conditions will decide the number of rounds to be attempted but all times on all sections will count. The layout of sections may be changed between rounds. All tests will be started by the drop of a flag after the competitor has signalled his readiness.

**M.S.A. DECLARATION**

a I declare that I have been given the opportunity to read the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association and, if any, the Supplementary Regulations for this event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I understand that motorsport can be dangerous and accidents causing death, injury, disability and property damage can and do happen. I understand that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss and I acknowledge and accept these risks.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry I agree that neither any one of or a combination of the MSA and its associated clubs, the organisers, the track owners or other occupiers, the promoters and their respective officers, servants, representatives and agents (the "Parties") shall have any liability for loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me as a result of participation in the Event including but not limited to damage to property, economic loss, consequential loss or financial loss howsoever caused. Nothing in this clause is intended to or shall be deemed to exclude or limit liability for death or personal injury. I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I declare that I have had the opportunity to read, and that I understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so.
