Minehead Motor Club Ltd Supplementary Regulations

1. Minehead Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans permit single venue Classic Reliability Trial on Sunday 6th September 2020 within Headon Woods, Minehead. TA24 8SR. OS map reference 181/940458.
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the international sporting code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. - 118780
ACTC Championship Round 7
2020 ASWMC Classic Reliability Trials Championship 39/2020
4. The event is open to all elected and fully paid up members of Minehead MC and to members of MCC, Camel Vale MC, Ross & District MSC, Bristol MC, Stroud & District MC, MG Car Club, Launceston & North Cornwall MC, Holsworthy MC, Torbay MC, MAC, North Devon MC, Windwhistle MC, Woolbridge MC and registered contenders in the ASWMC/ACTC and ASWMC Classic Trials Championships. The driver and passenger must produce a current RS Clubman Motorsport UK competition licence (minimum) and club membership card.
5. **ALL DRIVERS & PASSENGERS MUST PRODUCE A VALID**

6. The event is a Round of the
(a) 2020 Championship of the Association of Classic Trials Clubs
(b) 2020 ASWMC Classic Reliability Championship
7. The programme of the meeting will be:-
Competitors may arrive from 08:30 hrs
First Competitor will start at 09:30 hrs

DUE TO COVID-19, SCRUTINEERING & SIGNING ON will be by returning an electronic declaration and the appropriate forms prior to the event. These will be sent with final instructions.
8. **START AND FINISH**

The start will be within Headon Woods
Competitors should arrive at the venue at least 30 minutes before their starting time, which will be advised.
The first competitor will start at 0830 hrs and the remainder at 1 minute intervals thereafter in numerical order.
The finish will also be within Headon Woods.
9. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 14 sections and 2 special tests. Maximum speed between sections will be 10mph.
10. The event will consist of 9 classes as follows:
 - 1A Front-engined, front wheel drive production cars (which from 1/1/19 includes FWD vehicles fitted with a torque biasing differential)
 - 2 Production cars built prior to 1941 and the following: MG TC, Morgan 4-4 Series I, HRG 1100 & 1500, and Ford models (upright models to 1959) E04A, E494A, E4930A/B, E93A, E493A and 103E
 - 3 Front-engined, rear wheel drive production saloons (except vehicles in Class 6)
 - 4 Rear-engined, rear wheel drive production saloons up to and including 1300cc (except vehicles in Class 7) 10
 - 5 (a) Front-engined production sports cars (except vehicles in Classes 1 or 6) (b) Vehicles built from pre-1941 components (except vehicles in Class 2) and satisfying the tyre regulations in 10.11
 - 6 (a) Rear-engined, rear wheel drive production cars (except vehicles in Class 4) (b) Front-engined production cars fitted with torque biasing differentials as standard equipment.
 - 7 (a) Production cars modified beyond Permitted limits
(b) Rear-engined production cars fitted with torque biasing differentials as standard equipment

(c) Front-engined cars manufactured on a limited basis conforming to an accepted specification. Where modified beyond the accepted specification these cars will be classified in Class 8. These cars comply with either or both of 7 (c) (i) and/or 7 (c) (ii) below: 7 (c) (i) Have the rearmost part of the front seat cushion(s) forward of any part of the rear tyres 7 (c) (ii) Have a wheelbase of 90in (228.6cm) or greater
 8 (a) Non-production cars (b) Rear-engined cars (except vehicles in Classes 4, 6 and 7) (c) Front-engined cars manufactured on a limited basis (except those in Class 7) including those which: 8 (c) (i) Have the rearmost part of the front seat cushion(s) rearward of any part of the rear tyres, or 8 (c) (ii) Have a wheelbase less than 90in (228.6cm)
 90 Suzuki X90 Vehicles, running an original format engine block.

All cars will comply with the requirements as per the "Blue Book" and be Production Cars as defined in the Motorsport UK vehicle regulations, although special cars may compete in the appropriate classes.

Fire Extinguisher of AFFF category must be fitted and spill kits carried in all cars

11. The route will be defined by markers and arrows on site.

12. ENTRIES

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on at midday on the 29th August 2020. The entry fee is £35.00. Entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

Entry forms can be emailed to the Entries Secretary.

Due to present regulations, we will not be able to do the usual signing on in the morning, instead we will send out signing on sheets which you will need to return by email prior to the event.

Awards will be presented at the Club's Dinner & Dance in February. All major trophies are to be held for 11 months (or less if requested by the Club)

19. IDENTIFICATION - All entrants will require competition numbers which must be affixed in a prominent position to the front and rear of the vehicle. **Competitors will need to provide these themselves, after receiving their competition number in the final instructions.** Coloured discs (cars only) must be displayed prominently at the front of the vehicle.
20. Starting order will be as follows:
Cars will start after the Motorcycles in following class order 8, 7 and classes 1 to 6 in mixed order.
21. Marking will be as T.7.5.as printed, and certain hills may not be divided into sections and these will be noted at the start of the section. Six penalties will be given for failure of these hills. Certain hills may also contain a stop/restart test; other tests may be included. Some sections may have a different start and restart lines for different classes. T.6.4 to T.6.4.4 will apply, Hitting markers or leaving the boundary of the course as represented by the course markers. In the event of a tie, aggregate times on the Special tests will decide, if a tie still exists, the times on Special Test 1 will decide.
22. Practising will not be allowed on observed sections.
23. Any competitor reported to the Clerk of the Course for dropping litter (including cigarette ends and matches), or subjecting Marshals to unnecessary abuse, will be excluded from the results.
24. Passenger regulation T.4.1 is deleted meaning that Drivers may compete alone. Any passenger(s) who are carried must be carried as per T.4.1.8
25. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK will apply as written except for the following, which have been modified:
Advertising will not be permitted on competitor cars.
26. Competitors please note that there is the possibility of noise testing taking place at some stage during the event
27. **COVID-19.**
Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all competitors must adhere to the current (at date of event) government guidelines on social distancing and congregating in groups. A list of COVID-19 specific instructions will be released with the final instructions for the event.

Passengers: As per the latest MSUK and government guidelines, passengers from different households are permitted, but both driver and passenger must wear a face mask at ALL times when in the vehicle. Passenger regulation T.4.1 remains deleted so that drivers may compete alone if they wish.
