7. To consider a proposal from the Championship Secretary that Rule 3 of the Association be amended by the addition of the following wording:-

Individuals, who must be members of a member club within the Association, may register as a "Competition Member" on the payment of a fee which is to be determined by the Council on an annual basis (£3.00 for 1985). A Competition Member will become a Registered Contender in the ACTC Classic Trials Championship and will be issued with a Membership Card. Competition Members are eligible to compete in any event promoted or co-promoted by ACTC or where ACTC is invited and listed in the S.R. Competition Members are not entitled to any voting rights.

8. To consider if contenders in the ACTC Championship should be awarded points when they marshal or act as an official on an event counting towards the Championship.
9. To discuss methods of encouraging more teams in Class Trials.
10. Special Tests in Trials. Discussion on whether they should be used as a tie decider only or if the test is failed it is counted as a failed section.
11. Pressurised gas containers - mounting location and contents. General discussion on the problem.

12. A discussion on enforcing the Regulations particularly in connection with:-
- a) Seating of passengers.
  - b) Noisy vehicles.
  - c) Unlicenced vehicles.
  - d) Testing for free operation of the differential.
