Minehead Motor Club Ltd Supplementary Regulations

1. Minehead Motor Club Ltd will organise an Open Permit Classic Reliability Trial on Sunday 5th September starting at Headon Woods, Minehead. TA24 8SR. OS map reference 181/940458.
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The ACU, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. ACU Permit No. - TBA
ACTC Championship Round 3
4. The event is open to all affiliated members of the ACU Ltd.
5. **All ENTRANTS MUST PRODUCE A VALID**
ACU Trials Registration Card
Club Membership Card
MOT Certificate (where applicable)
ACTC Championship Card (where applicable)
6. The programme of the meeting will be:-
Competitors may arrive from 08:00 hrs
First Competitor will start at 09:30 hrs

SCRUTINEERING will return to a physical check on the morning of the event. SIGNING ON will be by returning an electronic declaration and the appropriate forms prior to the event, OR by signing the paper copy on the day. All competitors will have the choice.

7. **START AND FINISH**
The start will be at Headon Woods
Competitors should arrive at the venue at least 30 minutes before their starting time, which will be advised.
The first competitor will start at 09:30 hrs and the remainder at 1 minute intervals thereafter in numerical order.
The finish will also be within Headon Woods.
8. Public roads will be used to link sections. There will be at least 14 sections and 2 special tests en route, to act as tie deciders.
9. The event will consist of 6 classes

Class A Solo motorcycles of British manufacture, manufactured before 1st January 1970 (engine and frame)
Class B1 Solo motorcycles up to and including 225cc
Class B2 Solo motorcycles from 226cc up to and including 450cc
Class B3 Solo motorcycles not eligible for Classes B1 & B2. These are: Honda/Montesa 4Ride, Ossa Explorer, TRRS XTrack, Scorpa Long Ride, Gas Gas Randonne, Gas Gas Connect and Honda TRL
Class C Motorcycles over 450cc (single or multicylinders)
Class D Motorcycles with touring or trials sidecars
Class X Motorcycles which do not comply with classes A-C, to run for honours only.

As per the latest ACU guidelines, sidecars are permitted but must have crew members from the same household.

17. AWARDS will be presented as follows. A person may only win 1 award, with the exception of the Minehead Motor Club Ltd award.

Awards will be presented at the Club's Dinner & Dance in February. All major trophies are to be held for 11 months (or less if requested by the Club)

18. IDENTIFICATION - All entrants will require competition numbers which must be affixed in a prominent position to the front and rear of the vehicle. **Competitors will be provided with these at scrutineering and signing on.**

19. Starting order will be as follows:

Classes D, A, C, B1, B2, B3, X

20. Most sections will be sub divided (12-1), but certain hills may not be divided into sections and these will be noted at the start of the section. Six penalties will be given for failure of these hills. Certain hills may also contain a stop/restart test; other tests may be included. Some sections may have a different start and restart lines for different classes. Hitting markers or leaving the boundary of the course as represented by the course markers will incur penalties. In the event of a tie, aggregate times on the Special tests will decide, if a tie still exists, the times on Special Test 1 will decide.

21. Practising will not be allowed on observed sections.

22. Any competitor reported to the Clerk of the Course for dropping litter (including cigarette ends and matches), or subjecting Marshals to unnecessary abuse, will be excluded from the results.

23. All other General Regulations of the ACU Ltd will apply as written

24. PLEASE NOTE - This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. **Be especially careful near horses, SLOW DOWN, STOP AND SWITCH OFF YOUR ENGINE IF NECESSARY.**

25. Competitors please note that there is the possibility of noise testing taking place at some stage on the route.
