Minehead Motor Club Ltd Supplementary Regulations

1. Minehead Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans permit Classic Reliability Trial on Sunday 5th September 2021 starting at Headon Woods, Minehead. TA24 8SR. OS map reference 181/940458.
2. The Meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the international sporting code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Clubmans Permit No. - TBA
ACTC Championship Round 3
2021 ASWMC Classic Reliability Trials Championship 39/2021
4. The event is open to all elected and fully paid up members of Minehead MC and to members of MCC, Camel Vale MC, Ross & District MSC, Bristol MC, Stroud & District MC, Eastwood MC, Launceston & North Cornwall MC, Holsworthy MC, Torbay MC, MAC, North Devon MC, Windwhistle MC, Woolbridge MC and registered contenders in the ASWMC/ACTC and ASWMC Classic Trials Championships. The driver and passenger must produce a current RS Clubman Motorsport UK competition licence (minimum) and club membership card.
5. **ALL DRIVERS & PASSENGERS MUST PRODUCE A VALID**

Current MOT Certificate (where applicable)
RS Clubman Motorsport UK Competition Licence
Championship Registration Card (where applicable)
6. The event is a Round of the
(a) 2021 Championship of the Association of Classic Trials Clubs
(b) 2021 ASWMC Classic Reliability Championship
7. The programme of the meeting will be:-
Competitors may arrive from 08:00 hrs
First Competitor will start at 09:30 hrs

SCRUTINEERING will return to a physical check on the morning of the event. SIGNING ON will be by returning an electronic declaration and the appropriate forms prior to the event, OR by signing the paper copy on the day. All competitors will have the choice. Competitors using the REIS third party cover will need to sign the appropriate form at signing on.
8. **START AND FINISH**

The start will be at Headon Woods
Competitors should arrive at the venue at least 30 minutes before their starting time, which will be advised in final instructions. The first competitor will start at 09:30 hrs and the remainder at 1 minute intervals thereafter in numerical order.
The finish will also be at Headon Woods.
9. Public roads will be used to link sections. There will be at least 14 sections and 2 special tests, to act as tie deciders.
10. The event will consist of 9 classes as follows:
 - 1 Front-engined, front wheel drive production cars (which from 1/1/19 includes FWD vehicles fitted with a torque biasing differential)
 - 2 Production cars built prior to 1941 and the following: MG TC, Morgan 4-4 Series I, HRG 1100 & 1500, and Ford models (upright models to 1959) E04A, E494A, E4930A/B, E93A, E493A and 103E
 - 3 Front-engined, rear wheel drive production saloons (except vehicles in Class 6)
 - 4 Rear-engined, rear wheel drive production saloons up to and including 1300cc (except vehicles in Class 7) 10
 - 5 (a) Front-engined production sports cars (except vehicles in Classes 1 or 6) (b) Vehicles built from pre-1941 components (except vehicles in Class 2) and satisfying the tyre regulations in 10.11
 - 6 (a) Rear-engined, rear wheel drive production cars (except vehicles in Class 4) (b) Front-engined production cars fitted with torque biasing differentials as standard equipment.
 - 7 (a) Production cars modified beyond Permitted limits
(b) Rear-engined production cars fitted with torque biasing differentials as standard equipment

(c) Front-engined cars manufactured on a limited basis conforming to an accepted specification. Where modified beyond the accepted specification these cars will be classified in Class 8. These cars comply with either or both of 7 (c) (i) and/or 7 (c) (ii) below: 7 (c) (i) Have the rearmost part of the front seat cushion(s) forward of any part of the rear tyres 7 (c) (ii) Have a wheelbase of 90in (228.6cm) or greater

8 (a) Non-production cars (b) Rear-engined cars (except vehicles in Classes 4, 6 and 7) (c) Front-engined cars manufactured on a limited basis (except those in Class 7) including those which: 8 (c) (i) Have the rearmost part of the front seat cushion(s) rearward of any part of the rear tyres, or 8 (c) (ii) Have a wheelbase less than 90in (228.6cm)

90 Suzuki X90 Vehicles, running an original format engine block.

All cars will comply with the requirements as per the "Blue Book" and be Production Cars as defined in the Motorsport UK vehicle regulations, although special cars may compete in the appropriate classes.

Fire Extinguisher of AFFF category must be fitted and spill kits carried in all cars

11. The route will be defined by the route book, which will be issued with the final instructions. Markers and arrows may also be used to assist en route.

12. ENTRIES

The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on at midday on the 30th August 2021. The entry fee is £35.00. Entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Entry forms can be emailed to the Entries Secretary, or posted to the address shown in Item 13.

Should any of the minimum figures for each Class not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entry fees may be refunded up to the closing date.

16. PROVISIONAL RESULTS will be sent in writing via E-mail or post within 7 days of the event.

17. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulations C.5.

18. AWARDS will be presented as follows. A person may only win 1 award, with the exception of the Minehead Motor Club Ltd award.

Awards will be presented at the Club's Dinner & Dance in February. All major trophies are to be held for 11 months (or less if requested by the Club)

19. IDENTIFICATION - All entrants will require competition numbers which must be affixed in a prominent position to the front and rear of the vehicle. **Competitors will be provided with these at scrutineering and signing on.** Coloured discs (cars only) must be displayed prominently at the front of the vehicle.
20. Starting order will be as follows:
Cars will start after the Motorcycles in following class order 8, 7 and classes 1 to 6 in mixed order.
21. Marking will be as T.7.5.as printed, and certain hills may not be divided into sections and these will be noted at the start of the section. Six penalties will be given for failure of these hills. Certain hills may also contain a stop/restart test; other tests may be included. Some sections may have a different start and restart lines for different classes. T.6.4 to T.6.4.4 will apply. Therefore, no Hitting markers or leaving the boundary of the course as represented by the course markers. Brushing markers will be accepted at the marshals discretion. In the event of a tie, aggregate times on the Special tests will decide, if a tie still exists, the times on Special Test 1 will decide.
22. Practising will not be allowed on observed sections.
23. Any competitor reported to the Clerk of the Course for dropping litter (including cigarette ends and matches), or subjecting Marshals to unnecessary abuse, will be excluded from the results.
24. Following the 2020 event which ran without passengers due to social distancing measures, Passenger regulation T.4.1 is reinstated, meaning all cars must carry at least one passenger, in accordance with T.4.8.1
25. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK will apply as written except for the following, which have been modified:
Advertising will not be permitted on competitor cars.
26. Competitors please note that there is the possibility of noise/diff testing taking place at some stage during the event.
27. PLEASE NOTE - This event is routed along and/or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. **Be especially careful near horses, SLOW DOWN, STOP AND SWITCH OFF YOUR ENGINE IF NECESSARY.**
28. INSURANCE: Valid insurance for this event is mandatory. Minehead MC will obtain a blanket certificate of insurance from REIS to provide to those car competitors who need to use the scheme, third party cover to meet Road Traffic Act requirements on the road sections of this event. The basic rate, before any loadings is £15 (as negotiated by ACTC). If you wish to use the REIS scheme, and you comply with all the following Declaration points, it is only necessary to pay the fee and sign the insurance form at the start of the event. No letter of acceptance will be issued.
Automatic acceptance will be provided to all competitors who meet the following:
 - Age 19 or over
 - Has held a full driving licence for a minimum of 6 months
 - Has no more than 6 points on their licence.
 - Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years
 - The vehicle must have a valid MOT certificate, current road insurance and road tax, unless exempt from doing so.
 - Anyone aged 19 or under will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be aged 25 or older, or be a more senior member of their family.
 - All competitors must be a named driver on the road insurance.

Anyone falling outside of these limits can be referred directly to REIS Motorsport Insurance by calling 0115 965 1040 at least one working day prior to the event commencing – only in extreme conditions will insurance be refused, or the premium loaded.

Car competitors may make their own insurance arrangements, but this must include RTA cover while competing in this event.

Event insurance covering third party damage whilst on private land currently carries an excess of £450 per incident (see Appendix 2, paragraph 3, sub paragraph 3 of the 2021 Motorsport UK Yearbook). The organising club reserves the right to recover the cost of repair of any third party damage, up to a maximum of £450 per incident, from the entrant of any vehicle which causes such damage.
