- 10.1 **Proposal from Minehead MC MCC Bonus Rounds** Discussion Item Norton Selwood To increase the points Gold/Silver/Bronze awards on MCC events which are currently Bonus Rounds in ACTC Championship. The proposal it to increase from 5, 3 and 1 to 8, 5 and 3 points. Also given the endurance and reliability nature of these events a single point for finishing.
- 10.2 **Proposal from Motorcycle Co-ordinator Class ID Sticker Discussion Item** Chris Barham After conversations with many marshals/ observers at events, it seems many have difficulties identifying the class of a bike approaching them at a section. Whether that bike is to ride through a restart or take a deviation. While the onus is always on the competitor to do the correct Class identification stickers for Bikes would help the situation. The classes affected are Class A and Class B1/B2/B3. The suggestion is for example:

Class A displays a forward facing white circular disc, 75mm diameter (old tax disc size) with a black "A" displayed and Class B3 displays a yellow disc with a black "3" in it.

- 10.3 **Proposal from MCC Class S for Step-through Bikes**The proposal is to create a new 'Class S' for step-through bikes. Basically allows these bikes to compete without having to do the class B restarts as they remain fundamentally uncompetitive.
 - CLASS S Step-throughs and scooters, which must comply with the following requirements:
 - a) The machine must originally have been manufactured as a step-through or scooter.
 - b) There must be a nominal gap between the seat and the headstock (or bodywork at the headstock) of at least 250 mm.

Notes from the Motorsports UK Trials Committee meeting- 22nd March 2022

An update on the Diff testing within sporting trials was given. It was reported that the ACTC whilst not against a testing programme had decided not to progress this in the immediate future due to the complexity of dealing with many different car types and the total number of vehicles involved in the sport.

Catalytic converters.

The previous proposal to amend the section J rule has been rejected by the technical department. The intention now is to create a new rule in section T. This will allow cars not required to be fitted with catalytic converters by legislation to also compete in Trials without them.

Fire Extinguishers

The revised rules for Classic Trials are now in the electronic version of Blue Book. Concern was raised at the time taken for MS-Uk to respond to the queries.

Car Trials (PCTs) are proposing a new simplified and modernised class structure. If agreed to be implemented in 2023.

Proposal:

Class A – for post-2010 front wheel and rear wheel drive cars, including hybrid and electric.

Class B – for pre-2010 front wheel drive cars.

Class C – for post 1990 rear wheel drive production and sports cars.

Class D – for those cars ineligible for Class C due to age or modifications and rear wheel drive kit cars.

Tyres in Classic Trials

It is proposed to amend the existing tyre regulations and incorporate the 8mm rule within the Blue book. If agreed to be implemented in the 2023 Blue Book.

Sustainability.

This has become a very important topic and all Trials disciplines are encouraged to take an active look at sustainability within our sport. It was noted that this is also a focus for Forestry bodies.
